

KAMANJAB ATTRACTIONS – SHORT TOURS

PEET ALBERTS KOPPIE – NAMIBIA ROCK ENGRAVINGS

Peet Alberts, a Dorsland Trekker (Amelia's great-grandfather) who returned with his family from Angola during 1928 was the owner of the property "Kamanjab C" at the time that this rock-art site was discovered and declared a National Monument and historical site in South-west Africa, Namibia.

It is estimated that around 1500 rock engravings can be found at the Peet Alberts Koppie. The biggest engraving in Namibia of 330cm Giraffe is found here as well as depictions of human feet and abstract honeycomb and circular forms overlapping with an array of animal engravings.

An estimated 2000+ years ago the San Bushmen / Khoekhoen tribes were responsible for the engravings at the site they used as a social and spiritual gathering place in the area.

The Peet Alberts Koppie close to the village of Kamanjab is the second largest rock engraving site in Namibia and well worth a visit. Morning tour.



OVA-HIMBA VILLAGE – KAMANJAB

The Ova-Himba is one of the last traditional tribes in Namibia with a rich culture and traditional beliefs still practised in modern day Namibia. On this guided tour you will have the opportunity to experience an authentic and traditional village of the Himba people of North-west Namibia.

Around the Holy Fire their traditions and cultural beliefs will be explained with ample photographic opportunities of their huts, intriguing hairstyles and meeting the tribe members and children dressed in traditional wear milking their cows.

After the guided tour the Himba women get together and display hand-made jewellery and souvenirs for sale, all proceeds generated help to sustain the village. Morning tour.



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OTJITOTONGWE CHEETAH RESERVE – KAMANJAB

The Reserve is home to both tame and wild cheetah. Guests can view the feeding of the wild cheetah, ensuring superb photographic opportunities. Afternoon tour.

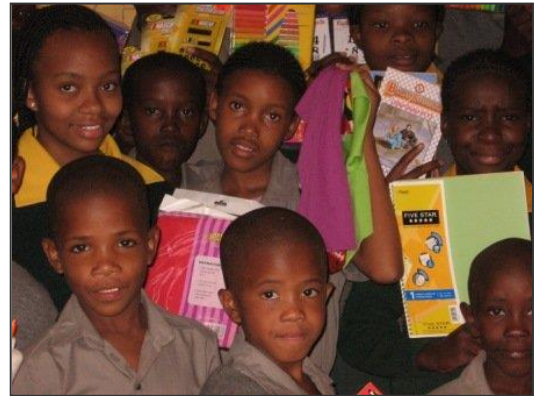
